Today, we seem to be living in a world of distrust, where people pick a side and never seem to listen to what the other side has to say. It is a world of wariness, of 'America First', of everything being fake news if it in any way disagrees with our own perception of the world. This book is, in many ways, the opposite of that, bringing light to the dark. And it is very welcome on my bookshelf.

In this thought-provoking autobiography, the author (Michael) throws the reader into a homophobic world in an attempt to help them to understand what it's like to be gay (openly or not). Written with panache, even flamboyance, it is well-balanced in terms of being informative but, also, in terms of being heartbreakingly personal. I enjoyed many aspects of this book.
